The Harare International Festival of the Arts (http://www.hifa.co.zw/), a six-day annual festival and workshop program will be held April 28 to May 3, 2015 in Harare, Zimbabwe in various venues in the capital showcasing the best of local, regional and international arts and culture in a comprehensive festival of theatre, dance, music, fashion, street performances and spoken word.

Since its inception in 1999, the Festival has received recognition for its support of arts and culture in Zimbabwe and is seen as a major contributor to development in this area. The Harare International Festival of the Arts is now the largest cultural event in Zimbabwe and among the eight major festivals in Africa. According to the festival organizers, last year's edition of the festival had 1,006 Zimbabwean artists and 239 artistes from outside the country performing at the event, and furthermore, the festival has been rated as one of the top 10 festivals in the world in a survey conducted by CNN.
